The City is seeking the professional services of a qualified consultant to provide a Feasibility Study for the implementation of a north-south bicycle and pedestrian connection along the Union Pacific Railroad between the Hammond-Snyder Loop Trail and Saratoga-Sunnyvale Road. This trail network segment was identified in the 2016 Bicycle Transportation Plan as one of a series of multi-use paths that, when joined together, would form the "Cupertino Loop Trail". The Cupertino Loop Trail would provide access around Cupertino, largely separated from vehicle traffic and primary support recreational riders and long-range bicycle trips.
