NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
2020-25 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)  
CONSOLIDATED PLAN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its meeting of Tuesday, June 2, 2020, the Cupertino City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider the 2020-25 CDBG Consolidated Plan. The 2020-25 CDBG Consolidated Plan is a five-year plan which outlines the City's housing and community development needs and provides an action plan on how the City intends to use its federal funds to address those needs. Federal regulations require that the 2020-25 CDBG Consolidated Plan be made available in public locations for community review for thirty days at [www.cupertino.org/housing](http://www.cupertino.org/housing): May 5 – June 5, 2020. The Housing Commission held a public hearing on this item on May 14, 2020. **In accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order No-29-20, this will be a teleconference meeting without a physical location. Members of the public will be able to observe and address the meeting telephonically or otherwise electronically from the City's website through procedures that will be detailed in the published meeting agenda.** If you wish to challenge the City Council's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written or electronic correspondence delivered to the City of Cupertino City Hall 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA 95014 at, or prior to, the meeting. Persons needing special assistance to attend the meeting under the Americans with Disabilities Act should email [cityclerk@cupertino.org](mailto:cityclerk@cupertino.org) or call 408-777-3200 at least 48 hours prior to the public meetings to ensure their needs can be appropriately accommodated. **IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Please be advised that pursuant to Cupertino Municipal Code 2.08.100 written communications sent to the Cupertino City Council, Commissioners or City staff concerning a matter on the agenda are included as supplemental material to the agenda item. These written communications are accessible to the public through the City's website and kept in packet archives. You are hereby admonished not to include any personal or private information in written communications to the City that you do not wish to make public; doing so shall constitute a waiver of any privacy rights you may have on the information provided to the City.
