1. Bid Acceptance. The City of Cupertino ("City") will accept sealed bids for its Sports Center Seismic Retrofit Project ("Project"), by or before Tuesday, July 7, 2020, at 2:00 p.m. All bids must be submitted in PDF format online at https://apps.cupertino.org/bidmanagement/index.asp. Bidders may login to the application using the same email address and password used to access bidding documents. To submit a bid, open the Sports Center Seismic Retrofit Project folder and click on the Electronic Submission tab. It is strongly recommended that bidders familiarize themselves with the web application prior to the bid date. Make sure to follow all bid instructions and include all required forms. Submitting a bid electronically can take more time than anticipated depending on the scope or the bid and the amount of information the bid is requesting, so please allow enough time to submit your bid by the stated deadline. bid closes.

2. Project Information.

- **2.1 Location and Description.** The Project is located at 21111 Stevens Creek Blvd., Cupertino, CA 95014 <Project location>, and is described as follows: This project involves a voluntary seismic upgrade on the existing Sports Center building. The concrete wall along the south and the freestanding columns along the north will be shear-strengthened with externally applied adhered FRP reinforcing. The concrete wall will be covered on both exterior and interior surfaces. The concrete columns will be wrapped on all four sides. To allow this application, existing architectural elements and finishes within the area of augmentation will be removed to expose the concrete surfaces. Such architectural elements and finishes that are impacted by this application will be restored upon completion. In addition, this project will also include accessibility improvements.
- **2.2 Time for Completion.** The project must be completed within 90 calendar days from the start date set forth in the Notice to Proceed, City anticipates that the Work will begin on or about September 8, 2020, but the anticipated start date is provided solely for convenience and is neither certain or binding.
- **2.3 Estimated Cost.** The estimated construction cost is \$ 1,000,000.

3. License and Registration Requirements.

- **3.1 License.** This Project requires a valid California contractor's license for the following classification(s): **B General Building**.
- **3.2 DIR Registration.** City may not accept a Bid Proposal from or enter into the Contract with a bidder, without proof that the bidder is registered with the California Department of

Industrial Relations ("DIR") to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, subject to limited legal exceptions.

- **4. Contract Documents.** The plans, specifications, bid forms and contract documents for the Project, and any addenda thereto ("Contract Documents") are available in electronic form only, and may be downloaded from City's website under "Open Bids" at: https://apps.cupertino.org/bidmanagement/Index.aspx and may also be available from a local or regional plan room or trade journal.
- 5. Bid Security. The Bid Proposal must be accompanied by bid security of ten percent of the maximum bid amount, in the form of a cashier's or certified check made payable to City, or a bid bond executed by a surety licensed to do business in the State of California on the Bid Bond form included with the Contract Documents. The bid security must guarantee that within ten days after City issues the Notice of Award, the successful bidder will execute the Contract and submit the payment and performance bonds and insurance certificates and endorsements and any other submittals as required by the Contract Documents and specified in the Notice of Award.

6. Prevailing Wage Requirements.

- **6.1 General.** Pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1720 et seq., this Project is subject to the prevailing wage requirements applicable to the locality in which the Work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to perform the Work, including employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, apprenticeship and similar purposes.
- **6.2 Rates.** These prevailing rates are on file with the City and available online at http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR. Each Contractor and Subcontractor must pay no less than the specified rates to all workers employed to work on the Project. The schedule of per diem wages is based upon a working day of eight hours. The rate for holiday and overtime work must be at least time and one-half.
- **6.3** Compliance. The Contract will be subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR, under Labor Code section 1771.4.
- 7. **Performance and Payment Bonds.** The successful bidder will be required to provide performance and payment bonds, each for 100% of the Contract Price, as further specified in the Contract Documents.
- **8. Substitution of Securities.** Substitution of appropriate securities in lieu of retention amounts from progress payments is permitted under Public Contract Code section 22300.
- 9. Subcontractor List. Each Subcontractor must be registered with the DIR to perform work on public projects. Each bidder must submit a completed Subcontractor List form with its Bid Proposal, including the name, location of the place of business, California contractor license number, DIR registration number, and percentage of the Work to be performed

(based on the base bid price) for each Subcontractor that will perform Work or service or fabricate or install Work for the prime contractor in excess of one-half of 1% of the bid price or, for construction of streets and highways, \$10,000 (whichever is greater), using the Subcontractor List form included with the Contract Documents.

- **10. Subcontractor Limit.** The prime contractor is required to self-perform at least 51% of the Work on the Project, as further specified in the Instructions to Bidders.
- 11. Bidders' Conference. A bidders' conference will NOT be held.
- **12. Instructions to Bidders.** All bidders should carefully review the Instructions to Bidders for more detailed information before submitting a Bid Proposal. The definitions provided in Article 1 of the General Conditions apply to all of the Contract Documents, as defined therein, including this Notice Inviting Bids.
