The 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan is a five-year plan which outlines the City's housing and community development needs and provides an action plan on how the City intends to use its federal funds to address those needs. The Citizen Participation Plan encourage citizens to participate in the development, revisions, and substantial amendments to the City's CDBG program documents. Federal regulations require that the Amended 2019-20 Annual Action Plan, Amended 2015-20 Consolidated Plan, and Amended Citizen Participation Plan be made available community review for five days at www.cupertino.org/housing: May 27– June 2, 2020. In accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order No-29-20, this will be a teleconference meeting without a physical location. Members of the public will be able to observe and address the meeting telephonically or otherwise electronically from the City's website through procedures that will be detailed in the published meeting agenda.
