NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at their regular meeting on **Tuesday, December 1, 2020 at 6:45 p.m.**, the City Council of the City of Cupertino will conduct a public hearing to consider Municipal Code Amendments to adopt glazing and lighting regulations to implement the Fiscal Year 2019/20 City Council Work Program items related to Dark Sky and Bird-Safe Design. (Application No. MCA-2019-003 and MCA-2019-004; Applicant: City of Cupertino; Location: City-wide). At a regular meeting of the Planning Commission held on Tuesday, October 27, 2020, the Commission recommended that the City Council adopt amendments to the City's Municipal Code to adopt glazing and lighting regulations relating to Dark Sky and Bird Safe design per Resolution #6914 by vote of 4-1-0 (Wang voting no).
