NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regular meeting of Tuesday, June 1, 2021, the Cupertino City Council conducted the second reading of Ordinance No. 21-2227: "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Cupertino amending City Code Chapter 10.90 of Title 10 (Public Peace, Safety, and Morals) to prohibit smoking in multi-unit housing and certain outdoor areas," with multi-unit housing/residence defined for the purposes of this Ordinance to include attached single family homes and other property containing two or more attached units, which includes a finding that adoption of the ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. Ayes: Paul, Chao, Moore, Wei and Willey. Noes: None. Abstain: None. Absent: None. This ordinance was enacted and will go into effect thirty (30) days from that date. If you wish to challenge the City Council's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written or electronic correspondence delivered to the City of Cupertino City Hall at, or prior to, the meeting.
