

Blackberry Farm Pool Facility Rules

- All patrons must wear wristbands in the facility, for their designated swim block, even if they do not plan on getting in the water
- Lifeguards will announce 30, 15, and 5 minute warnings for the end of the swim block
- All patrons must get out of the pool by the end of the swim block, even if they are staying for multiple blocks
- All life jackets must be checked by a lifeguard when entering the facility. Only Coast Guard approved life jackets allowed. If you are wearing a life jacket, you must have a parent in the water within arms reach at all time. No other inflatables allowed, toys included
- No diving allowed anywhere in the facility
- No breath-holding games, swimming lengths under the water, pushing or shoving patrons into or in the water, carrying patrons on shoulders, hands around the neck, or hanging on the pool buoys allowed in the facility
- Running is only allowed on the grass. No running on the pool deck
- All food and drink must be consumed on the grass and not on the pool deck or benches
- No alcohol, drugs, or glass containers allowed anywhere in the facility

Lifeguards have the full authority and may enforce rules not listed as situations warrant.

Pool Toys & Items

- Proper swim attire must be worn in the pool. No jeans or cotton clothing allowed
- Water specific balls are allowed in the pool if they are volleyball size and smaller
- No throwing balls, toys, or other items on the grass
- Kick boards and pull buoys are allowed for water exercise. They may not be used as a flotation device
- Goggles that cover the eyes and nose are allowed. Snorkel breathing masks are not allowed
- Flippers or Mermaid tails are not allowed in the facility

Age Restrictions

- Children 11 and younger must have a parent in the facility. In order to swim in the deep end of either pool, children must pass the swim test
- Children 7 and younger must have a parent within arms reach at all times in the pool, regardless of passing the swim test

Swim Test Rules

1. Swim two laps width-wise of freestyle with arms coming out of the water
2. Tread water for 30 seconds with chin above the water

Lifeguards have the full authority and may enforce rules not listed as situations warrant.
