4. I understand that any deviation or modification to the Debris Recovery Plan must be approved in writing in advance by the City Environmental Programs Division.
5. I understand City staff may visit the project site to verify compliance and proper material sorting is being conducted during the project.
6. I will instruct all site workers and subcontractors about sorting waste debris correctly on site.
7. I will separate all trash from all recyclable and/or recoverable building materials. All trash separated will be hauled by Recology in accordance with the municipal code and the City's franchise agreement with the City's waste hauler, Recology South Bay.
8. I understand that all treated wood waste (TWW) such as pressure treated lumber, must be handled as hazardous material and may not be mixed in Recology debris boxes. If disposing TWW through self haul, please contact the receiving facility for special handling instructions and to confirm their acceptance of those materials.
9. I understand that in addition to submittal of the Debris Recovery Plan, the complete or partial demolition of a structure (excluding interior demolitions and commercial tenant improvements) requires a PCB SCREENING ASSESSMENT FORM available at www.cupertino.org/greendev. This form must be submitted and approved by the City before receiving the permit for demolition.
10. I understand it is the responsibility of the building permit applicant/owner and/or their agent/contractor to provide accurate and complete information, including supplemental documents as needed by the the City and failure to do so will delay building permit approval and/or release of the
