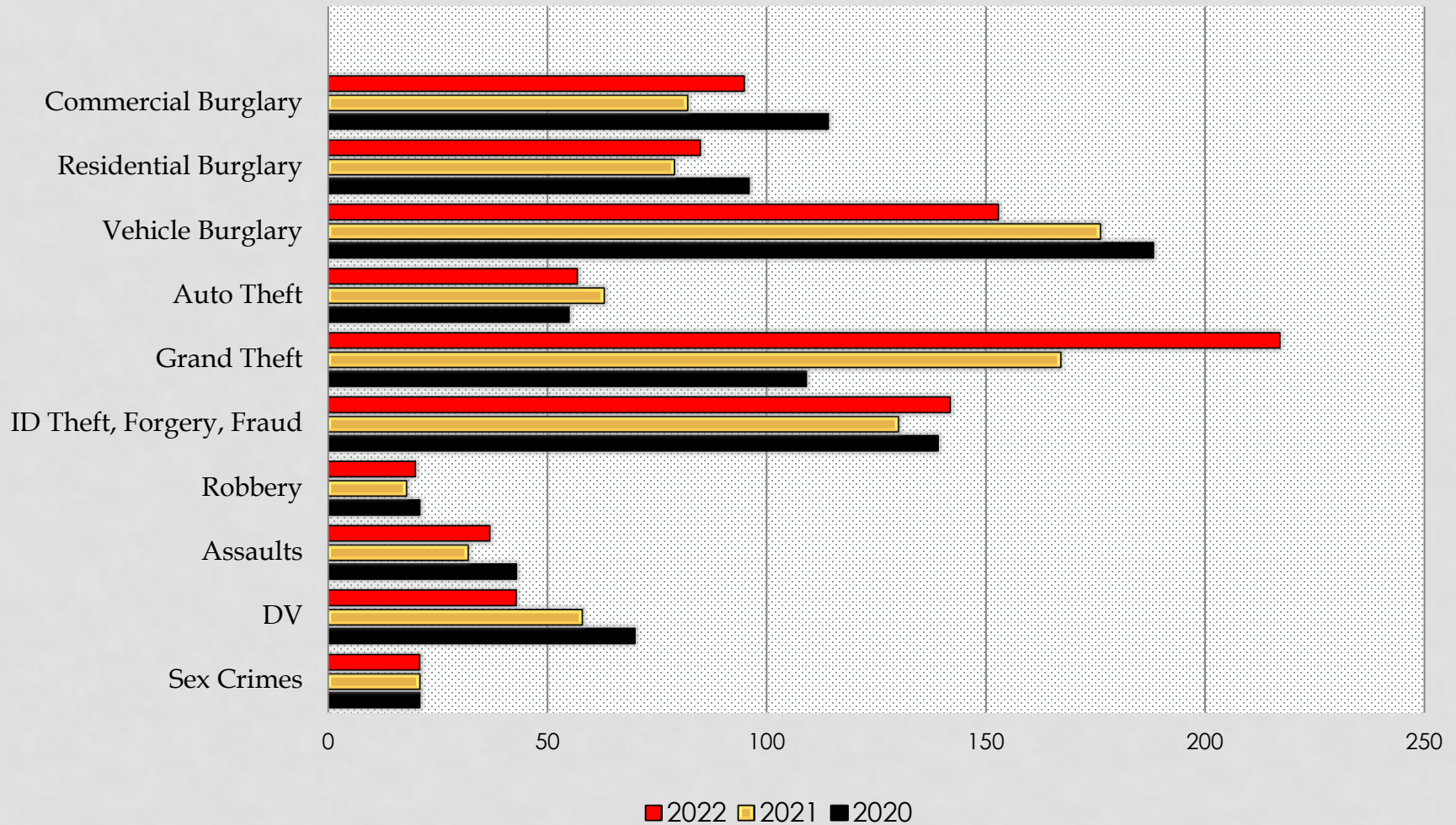

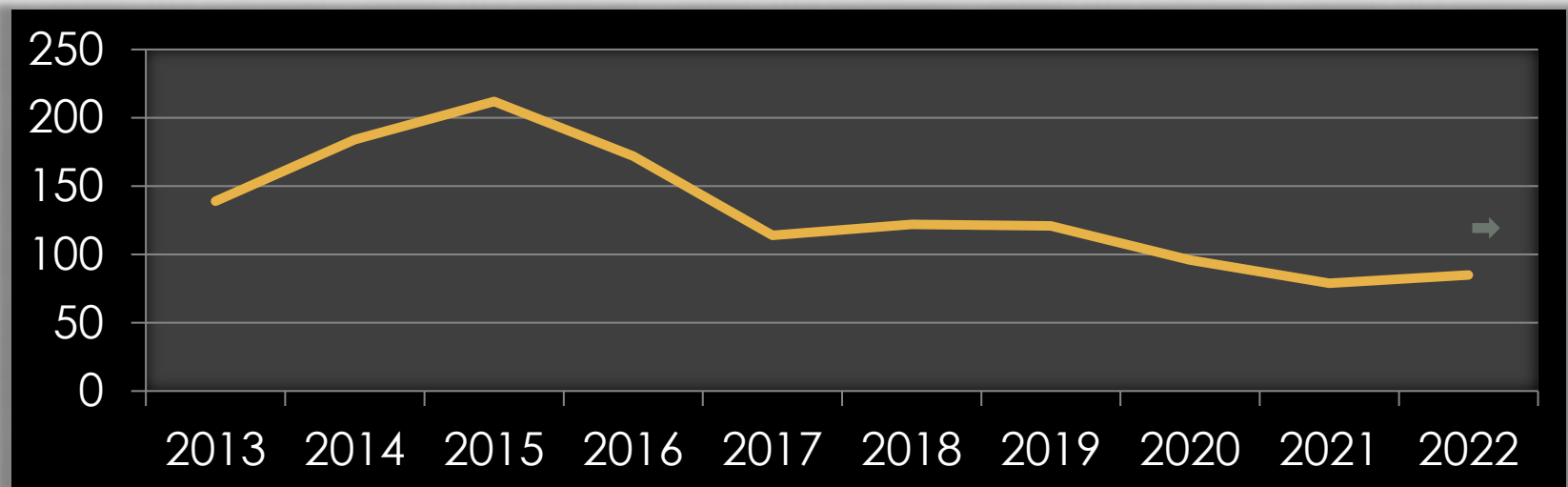

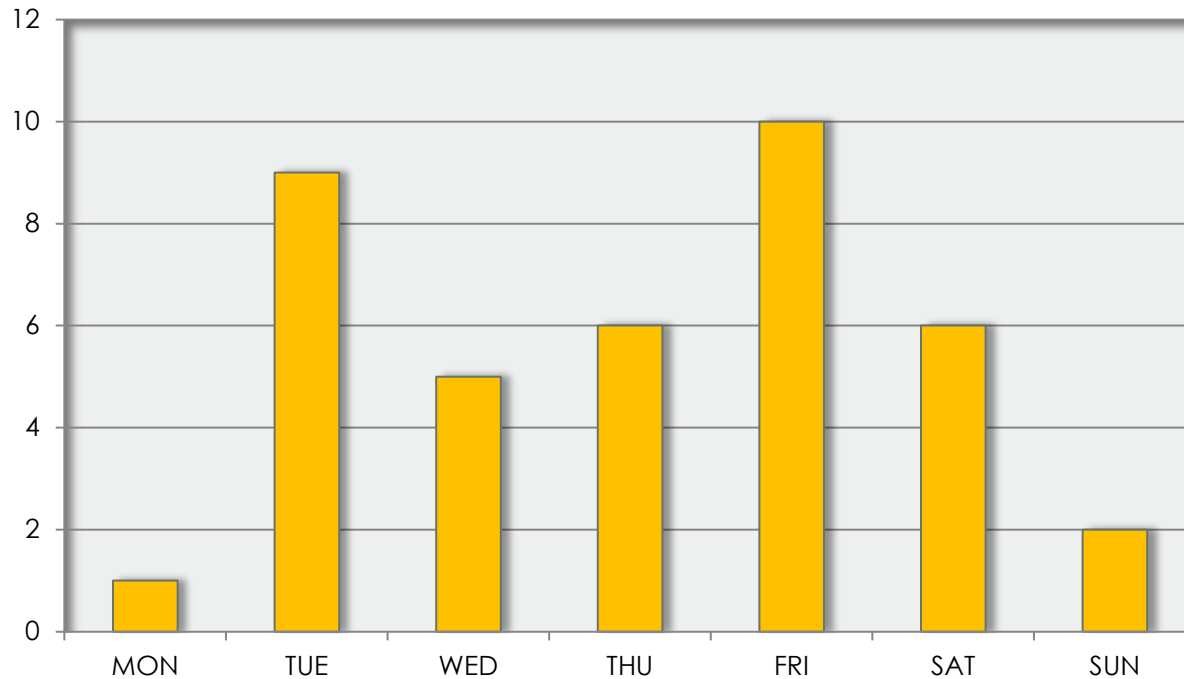

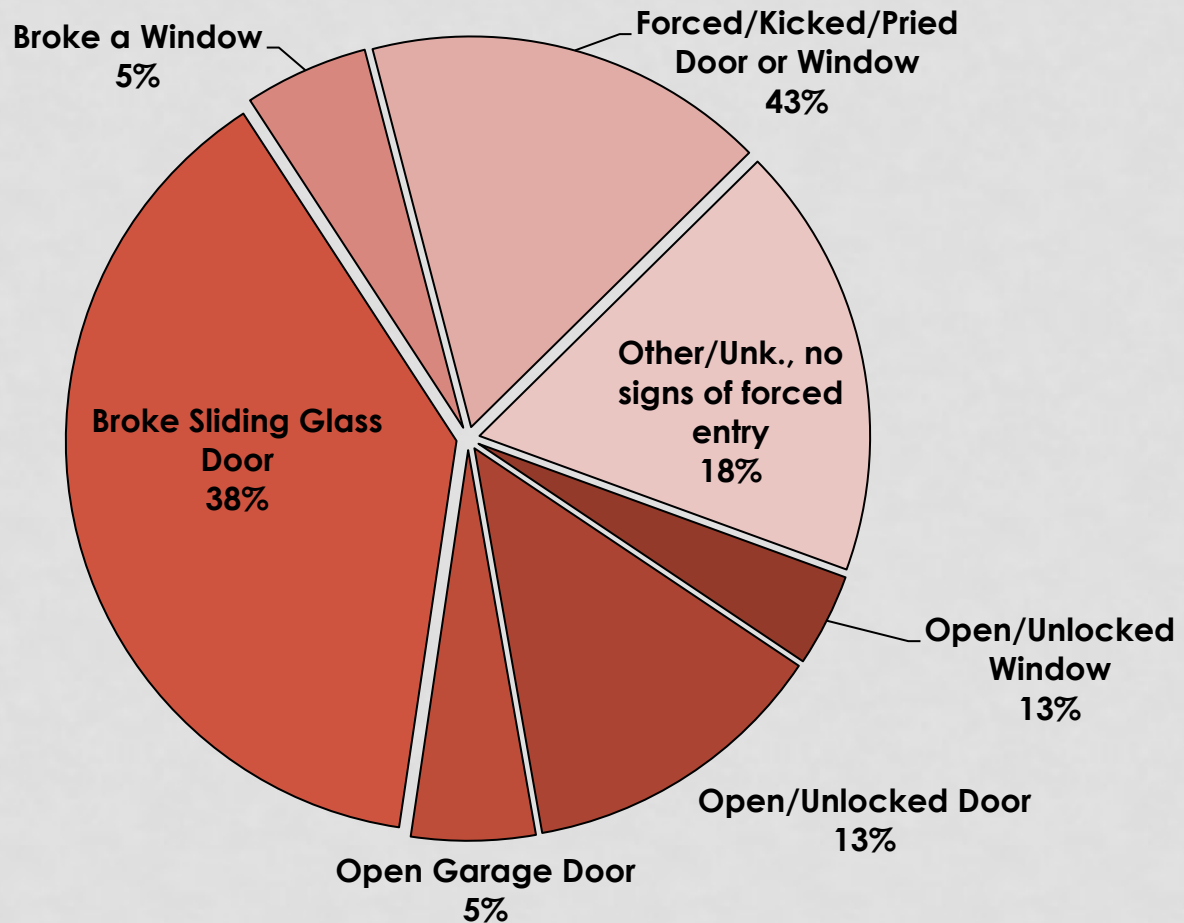
Day of Week



In 46 of reported cases, the time of burglary occurred over the course of multiple days and the exact day of week the burglary occurred is unknown.

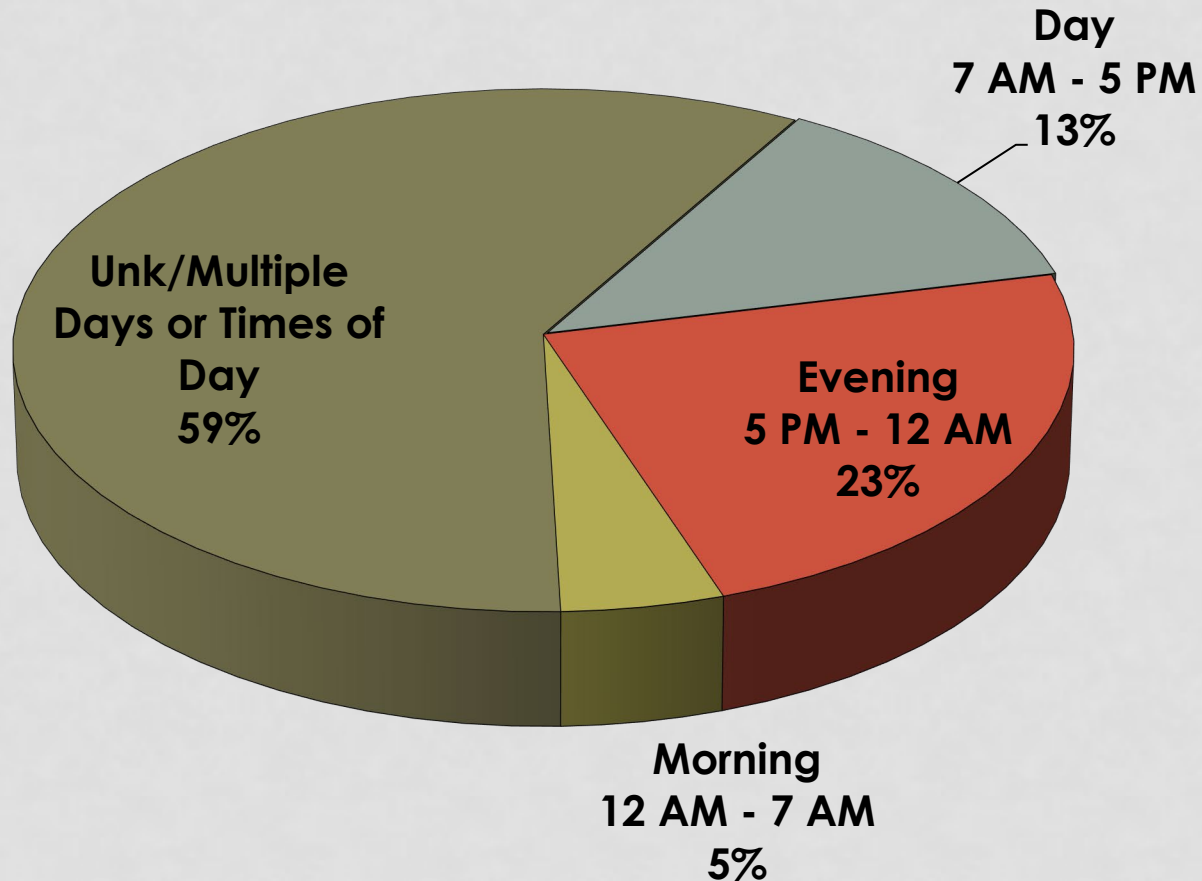

Method of Entry



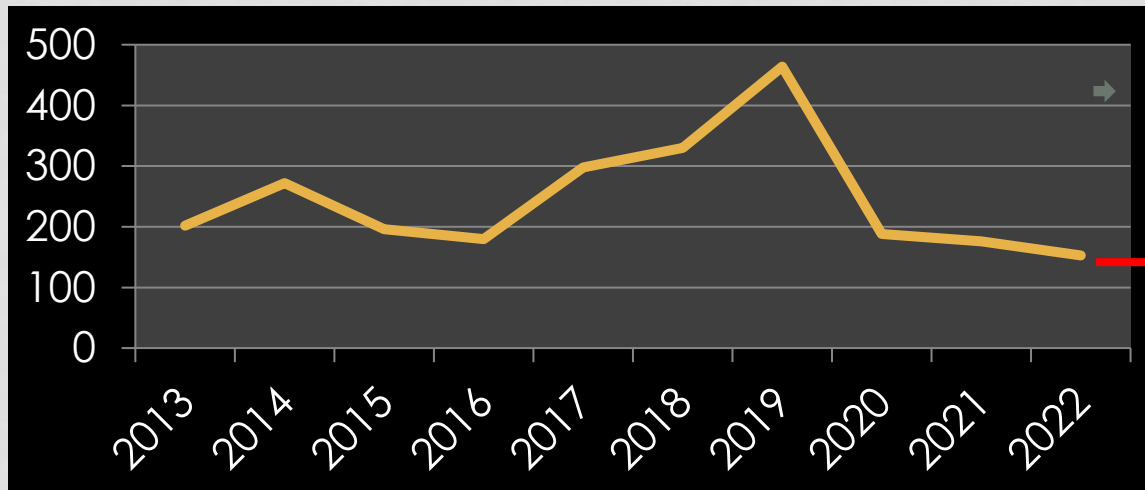

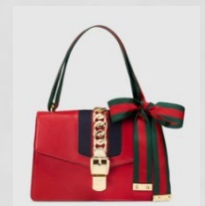

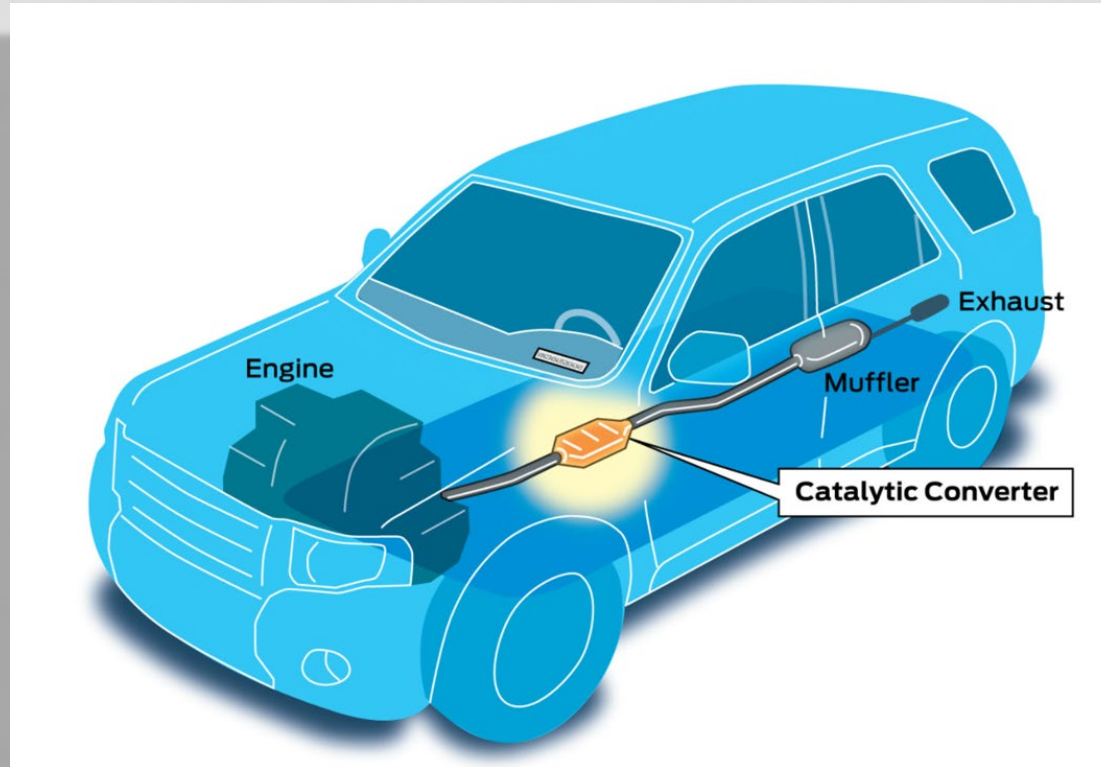
VEHICLE BURGLARIES

Prevent Becoming a Victim:

- Do not leave valuables in car, especially in plain view
- Do not leave windows or sunroof open
- Do not leave doors unlocked
- Do not leave keys in the vehicle
- Do not leave the garage door opener in plain view
- Do not leave documents in vehicle which may contain sensitive, personal information
- Do not move valuable items to trunk while in public view
- Park your vehicle in the garage if possible

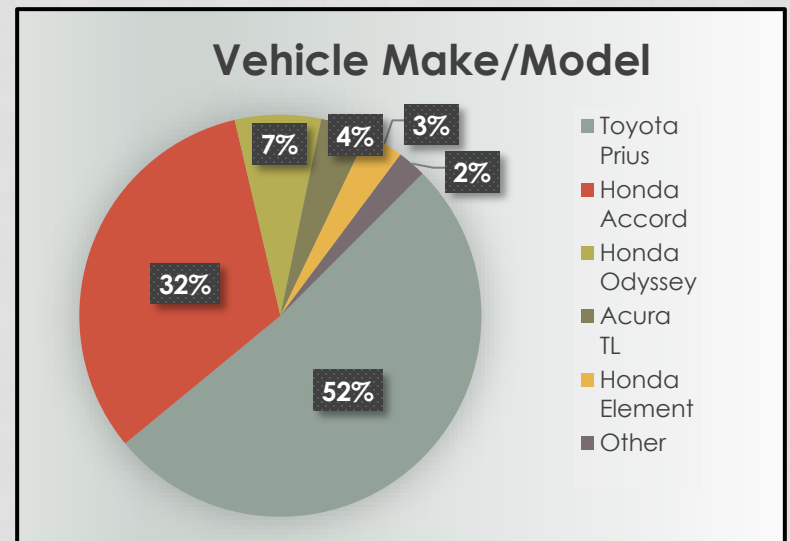
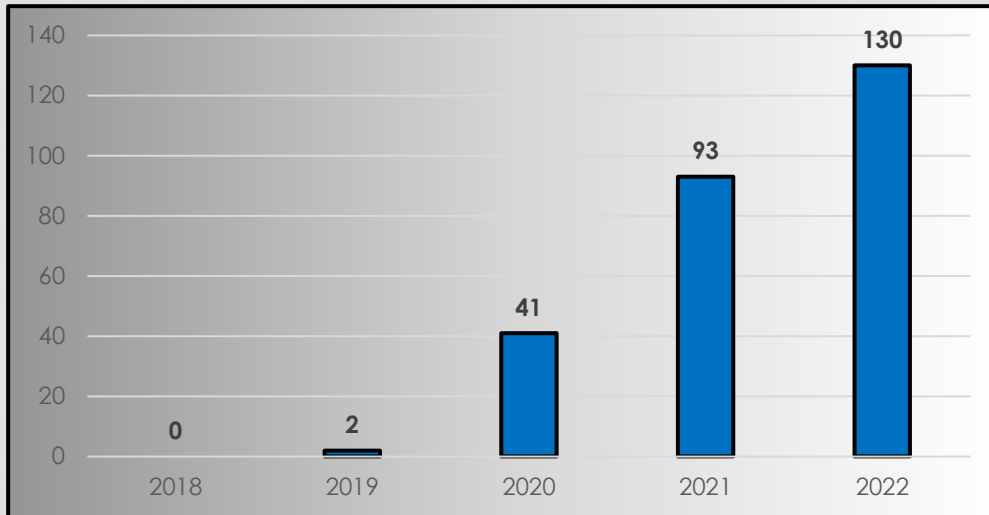


CATALYTIC CONVERTERS
