The undersigned owner/manager applies for a permit to operate an animal facility and agrees to operate according to all applicable state and local regulations, laws and such inspection procedures needed to ensure compliance. Owners of kennels and pet shops certify that all dogs more than four (4) months of age be kept in the facility and have a valid and current anti-rabies vaccination.
