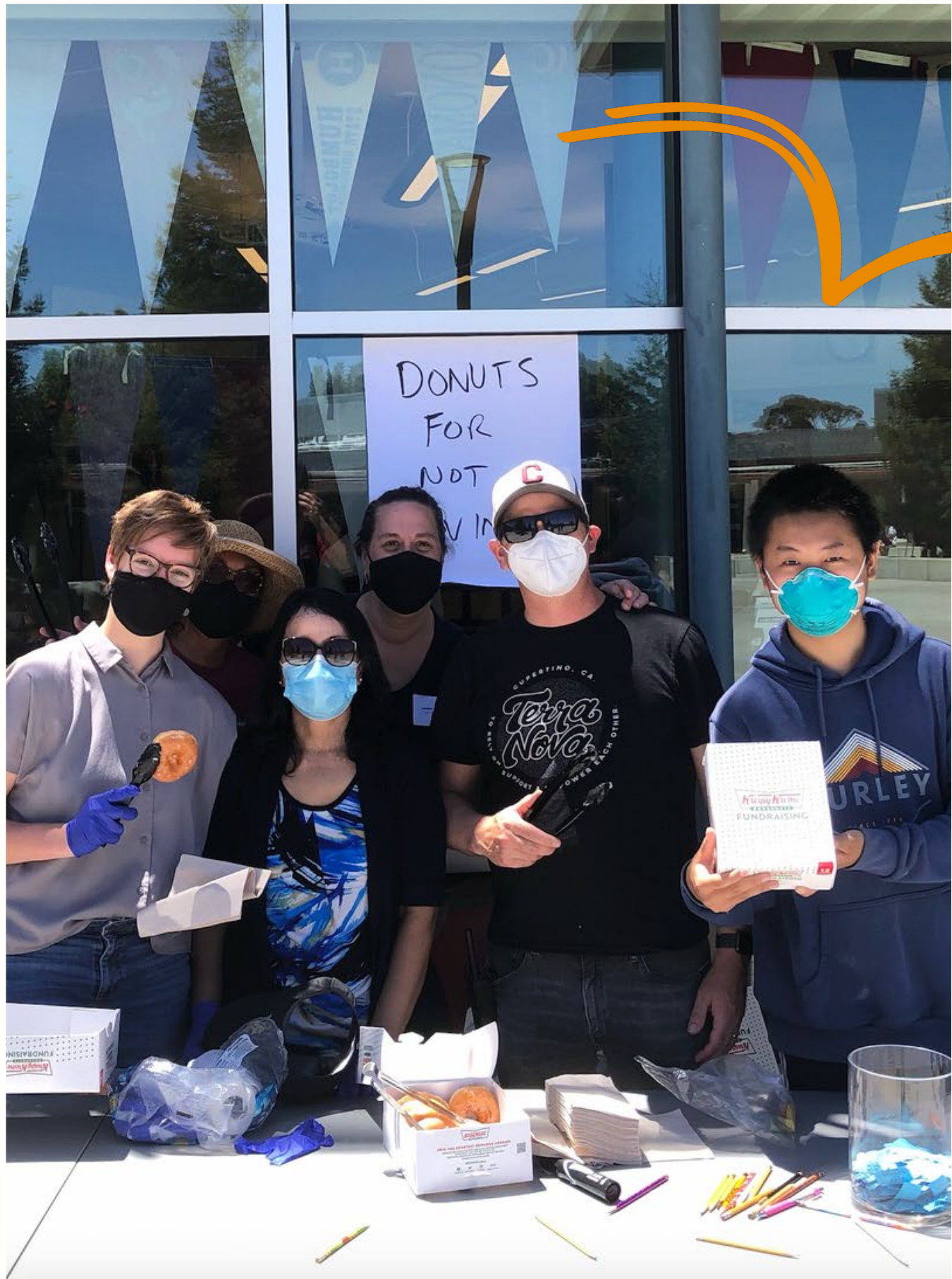

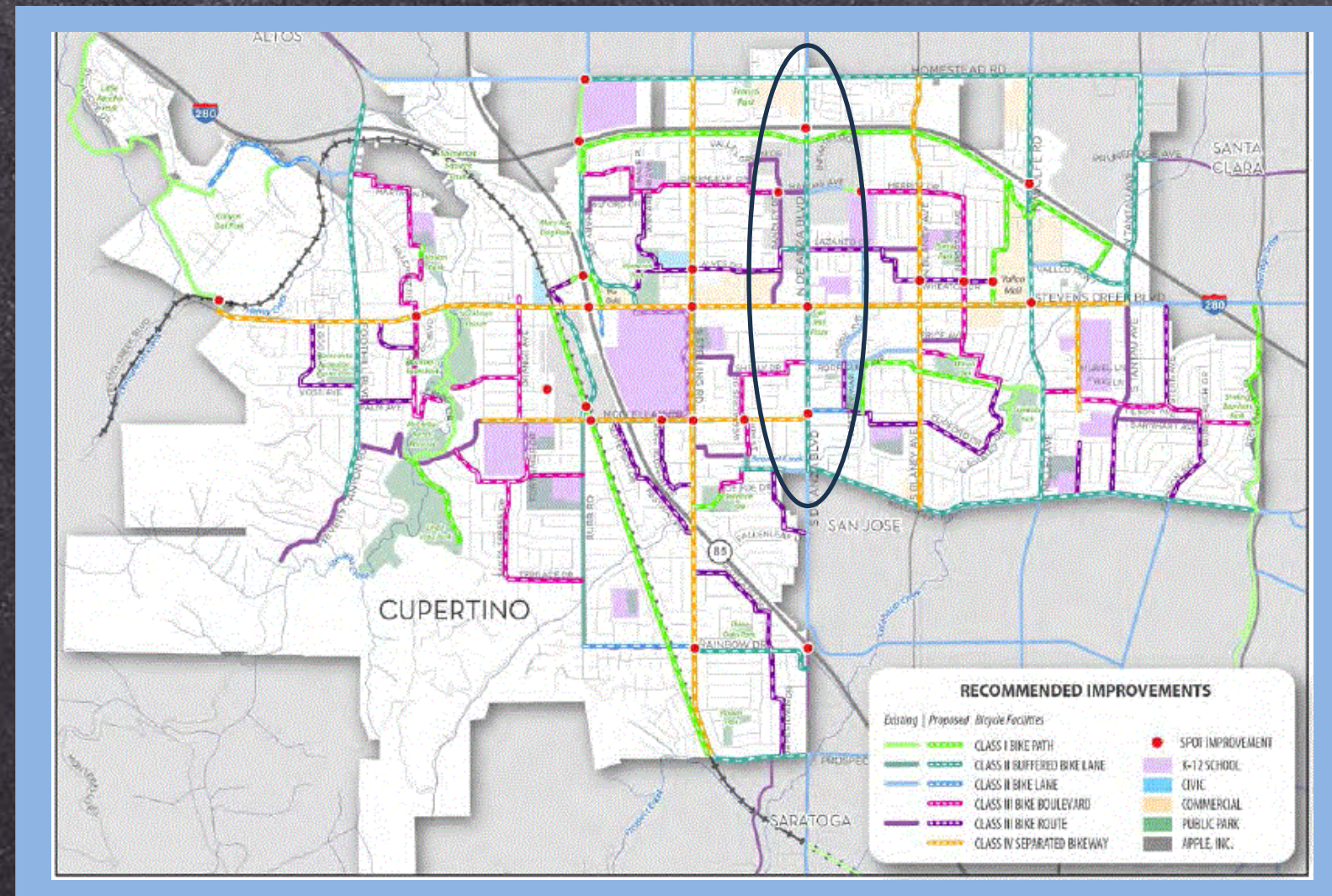

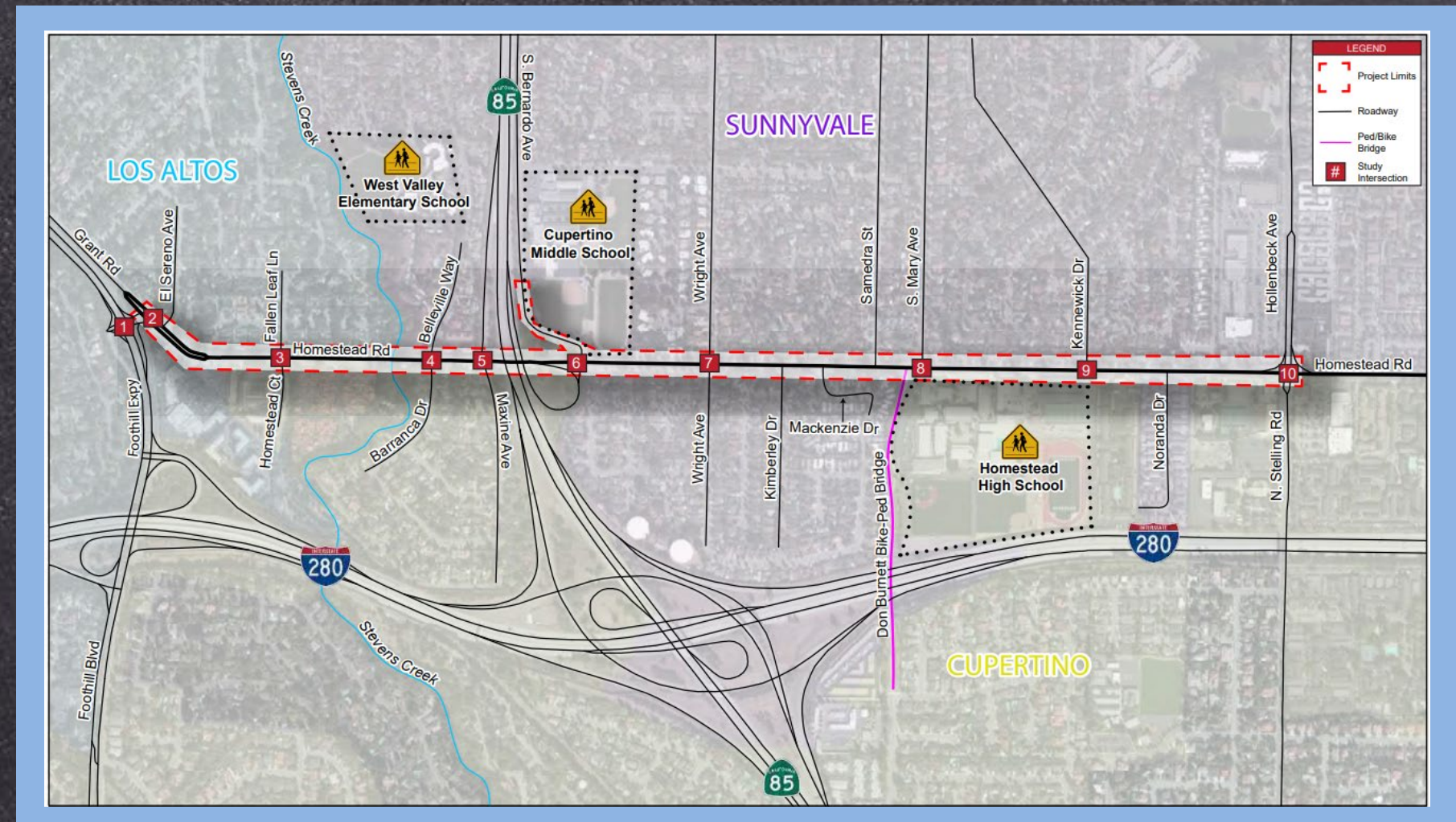
## De Anza Buffered Bike Lanes
