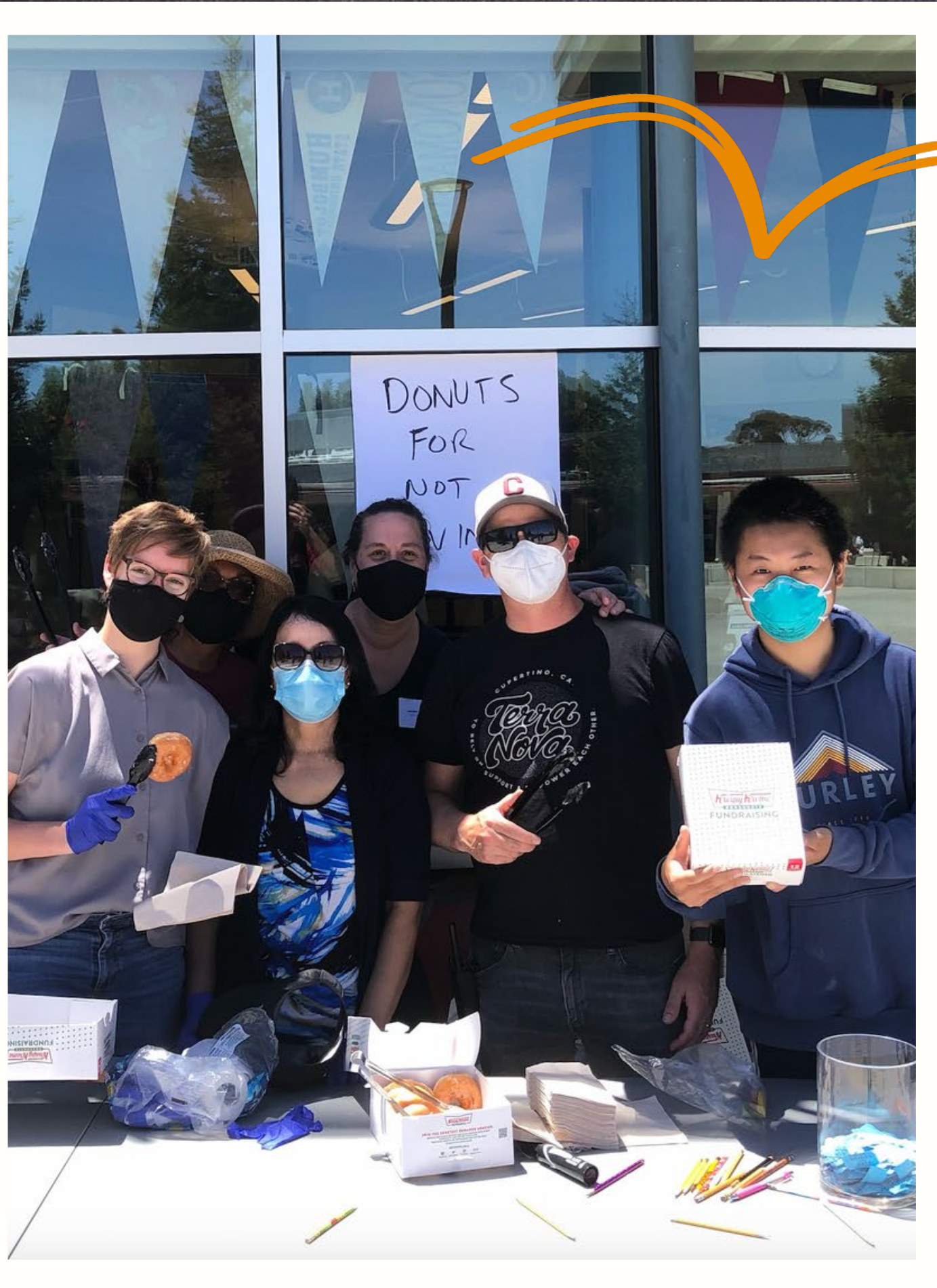

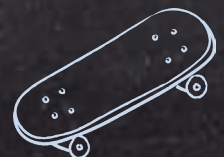

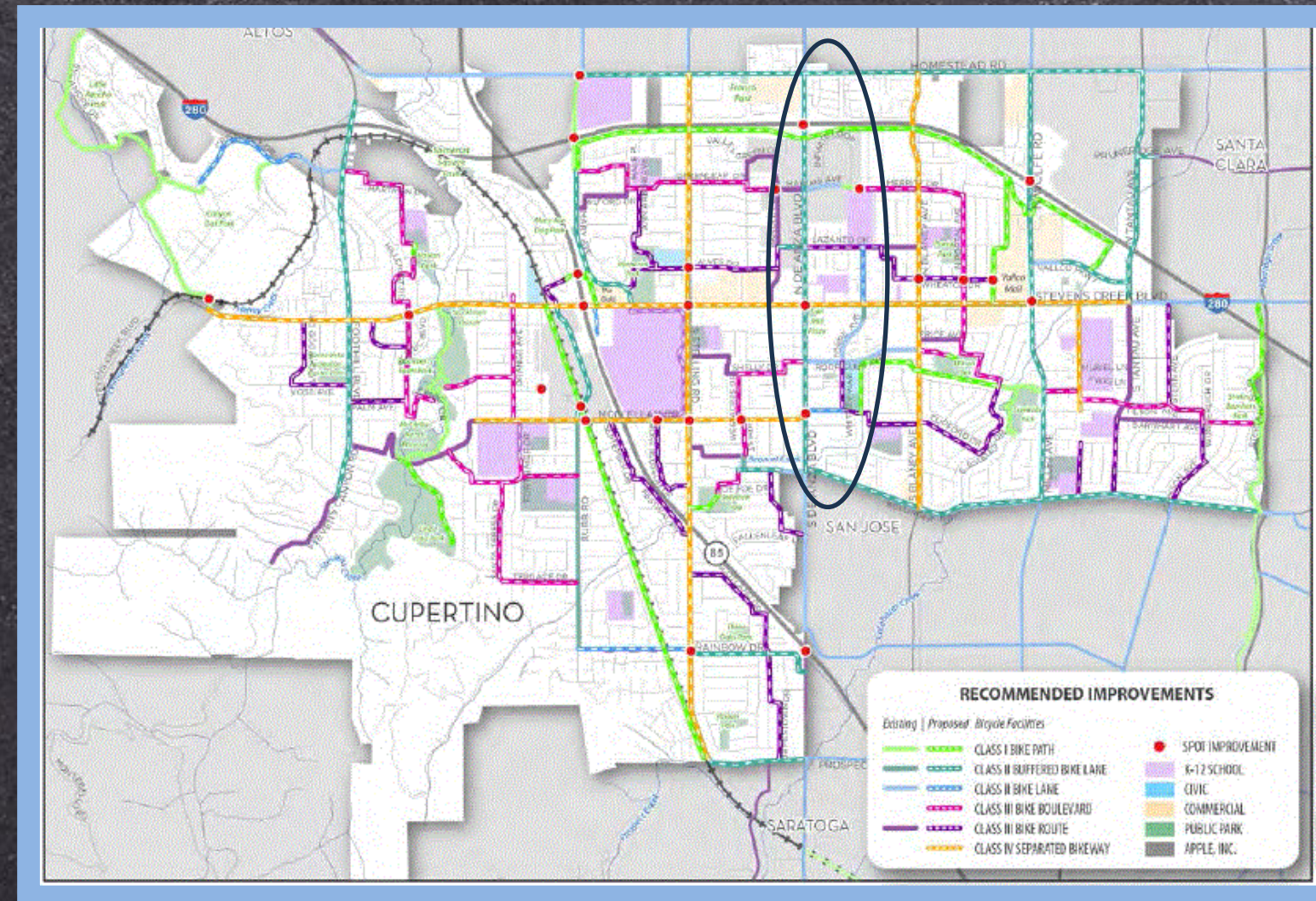


McClellan Road Protected Bikeways Phase 3
