NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING
AND ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at their regular meeting of Tuesday, April 16, 2013 the Cupertino City Council will conduct a public hearing to begin review the 2013-14 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) public service grants, capital project allocation and the 2013 draft Annual Action Plan.

The City Council meets at 6:45 p.m., Community Hall, Council Chambers, 10350 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, California. Interested parties are invited to attend and be heard. If you wish to challenge the City Council's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Cupertino City Hall at, or prior to, the public hearing.

The Annual Action Plan describes the proposed activities to be implemented with the fiscal year 2013-2014 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The Annual Action Plan is a one-year plan which describes the eligible programs, projects and activities to be undertaken with funds expected during the program year (Fiscal Year 2013-2014) and their relationship to the priority housing, homeless and community development needs of the City of Cupertino.

Federal regulations require the draft Annual Action Plan be made available in public locations for community review for thirty days. The plan will be available at the Cupertino Library and City Hall beginning March 22, 2013. Comments are due to the Community Development Department no later than 5:00 p.m. April 22, 2013. Comments may be addressed to Vera Gil, Senior Planner, City of Cupertino, 10300 Torre Avenue, Cupertino, CA 95014.

Persons needing special assistance, including translation services, to attend the meeting under the Americans with Disabilities Act should call at least 48 hours prior to the public meetings to ensure their needs can be appropriately accommodated. All public meetings are held in locations accessible to those with mobility impairments.
