NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that a general municipal election will be held in the City of Cupertino on Tuesday, November 4, 2014, for three full-term seats on the City Council. The polls will be open between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.

Incumbents Barry Chang, Orrin Mahoney, and Mark Santoro currently occupy those seats. Orrin Mahoney is not eligible for re-election because of term limits. If no one, or only one person, is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by Section 10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

Individuals interested in running for office may obtain nomination papers from the Cupertino City Clerk's Office, 10300 Torre Ave., from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays and 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Fridays. The nomination period is July 14 to August 8. Candidates must be registered voters within the corporate limits of the City of Cupertino.

If an incumbent fails to file Nomination Papers for his office by August 8 at 4:30 p.m., the nomination period will be extended by five days to August 13 at 5:30 p.m. During this time, any eligible candidate except the incumbent(s) may file Nomination Papers during regular business hours as noted above. Candidates would also have the opportunity to withdraw Nomination Papers during the extension.
